

Tips to help pace of play

- Keep up with the group in front of you and allow faster players to play through.
- Plan your shot while walking/riding to your ball or while others are playing. Be ready to play when it is your turn.
- Walk briskly between shots or drive the cart to your next shot without delay.
- Proceed directly to your golf ball, do not follow others unless assisting in a search and remember there is no penalty for hitting out of turn in stroke play.
- Take several clubs with you to your ball so you are prepared to play.
- Play a provisional ball if you think the original ball may be lost or out of bounds.
- Please use continuous putting rules when possible. Putt out and proceed to the next tee to record your score.
- All distances are measured to the center of the green.

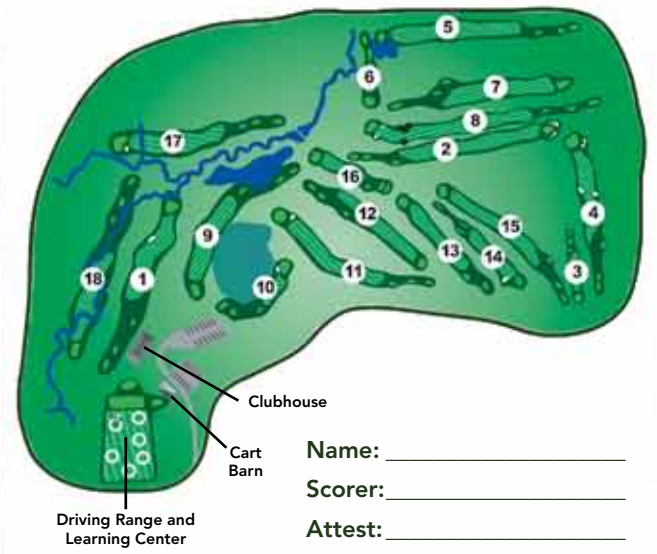
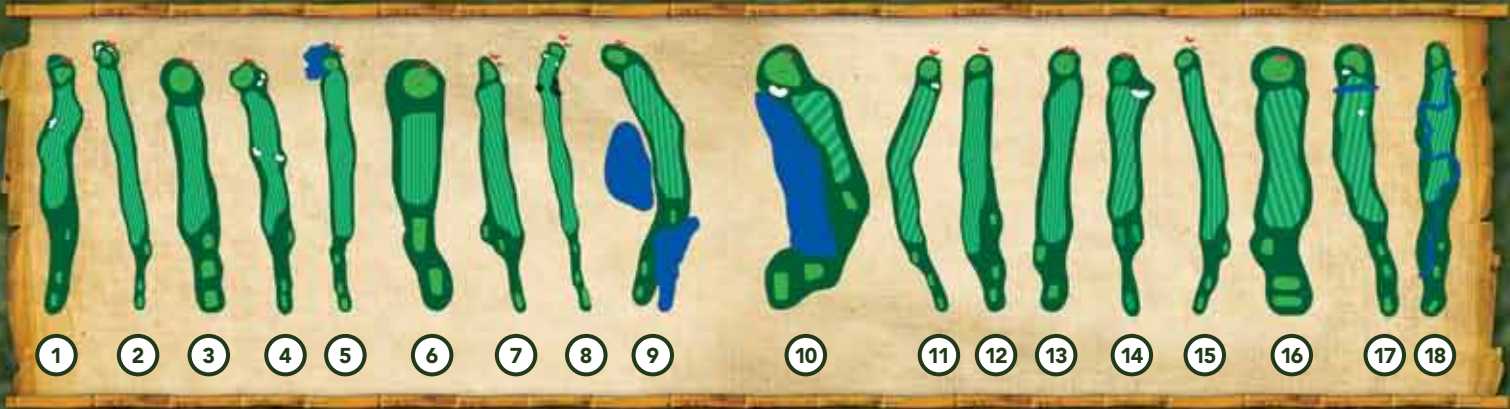
- **Red disc in fairway** 100 yards
- **White disc in fairway** 150 yards
- **Blue disc in fairway** 200 yards
- **Gold disc in fairway** 250 yards

Course Rules

- USGA rules govern all play except where modified by local rules; no fivesomes permitted.
- Please keep pace with the group ahead.
- Please repair ball marks, replace and repair divots, and rake bunkers. Riding carts must stay on the path around tees and greens, at least 30 feet from these areas, and cart path only on all par 3's.
- Safari Golf Club is a **SOFT SPIKE ONLY** facility.
- All perimeter fencing on holes 4, 5, 6, 16, 17, 18 and white stakes/lines determine out of bounds. Please abandon ball and show respect to our golfing neighbors.
- Red stakes define lateral hazards and yellow stakes define water hazards.
- Players will be placed in foursomes when possible.
- Private coolers are prohibited, and each golfer must have his/her own set of clubs.
- All alcoholic beverages must be purchased at Safari Golf Club - **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Any violators are in violation of Ohio law and will be removed from the facility.
- Management is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property or injuries.
- Golfers are responsible for any personal property damage or personal injury they cause on the course or adjoining property. Anyone not following the rules or causing damage to the course may be removed and/or prosecuted.
- Expected pace of play is 4 1/2 hours or less. Pace of play is monitored. Slow play will not be tolerated.
- Environmentally sensitive areas are marked in one of the following methods:
 - *Blue posts, blue lines, or signs noted as environmental.*
- Please note that the following procedure will be used:
 - *Abandon the ball, do not enter area to search, take one club length relief from point the ball crossed the line of the environmentally sensitive areas, and drop the ball with no penalty.*
- Players are asked to adhere to the dress code. Players must wear shirts at all times. Tank tops not allowed.
